It is not dangerous to humans, but it can kill thousands of pigs if it ends up in pig sties. Therefore, it is not allowed to take food purchased or brought from abroad into our holding. This also applies to homemade products.



AVOID AFRICAN SWINE FEVER

3 top tips

- 1** Do not take meat home when you have been travelling. African swine fever can survive in meat for a long time.
- 2** Do not order meat from abroad.
- 3** ALWAYS dispose of waste food in a closed rubbish bin.
