FLAMMABLE STORAGE ON THE FARM

Storage of flammables on farm (maximum amount)	
Diesel oil tank:	litres

INSTRUCTIONS IN THE EVENT OF A POWER CUT

- Will animals suffer from heat stress or exposure to drafts from emergency ventilation?
- Check whether emergency ventilation is open in all housing units.
- Limit heat stress (sprinkling).
- Ensure that no pollution results from power failure to pumps etc.
- If a power cut lasts over two hours, call the electricity supplier to check when power will be restored.
- Start the emergency generator if needed.

STOPCOCK/MAIN BREAKER

Stopcock/main breaker locations are indicated on the layout map

FIRE AND EVACUATION INSTRUCTIONS

If you cannot extinguish the fire yourself:

1. CALL 112 and state:

- Address
- Name and number you are calling from
- Nature of incident
- Any injuries
- Any escaped animals

2. Contact the owner of the farm

3. Start rescue and fire-fighting procedures:

- Close doors and windows.
- If possible, remove animals, pressurised bottles, fertiliser and chemicals.

4. On arrival of the Fire Service, inform them of:

- The location of the fire and its extent.
- Any injured persons and animals not yet rescued
- Map of layout showing access points, etc.

Location of fire extinguishing equipment – see map of layout.

SLURRY – LEAKAGE / CHEMICAL, OIL SPILLS, ETC.

If the event of a severe leakage or failure of a slurry tank.

1. CALL 112 and state:

- Address
- Name and number you are calling from
- Nature of incident and extent of leakage
- Is there a risk of pollution to a water course, borehole, etc?

In event of minor leakage

- Contact environmental authority only.

2. Contact the owner/manager of the farm

3. Preventive actions:

- Block with soil/straw to prevent slurry/chemicals from leaking into water course/drainage system
- If there is any leakage into the drain, block the watercourse with soil/straw, etc.
- Inform the fire service/environmental authority of the location, extent, etc.
- Show the layout map
