## Requirements for GPS extracts when applying for dispensation

On the 1<sup>st</sup> of May 2016 new requirements for GPS extracts related to dispensations entered into force. If the application for dispensation is to be considered as valid, the attached GPS report must satisfy the following requirements.

It must:

- be a PDF file, generated by the GPS company<sup>1</sup>
- show time of start and stop for the report (at least seven days prior to wash and disinfection)
- show the correct registration number
- show the vehicles' position (country code *and* either addresses or coordinates) at least every 30 minutes of the vehicle's driving time.
- show a continuous mileage counter (km)
- show the GPS company's logo/watermark

Furthermore, dispensations are only given if:

- the haulier *and* the exporter are both DANISH approved
- the haulier *and* the exporter are both QS approved (this is a precondition for DANISH approval) – or are underway in the QS approval procedure
- the vehicle has been set up to automatically deliver GPS data to our servers – or this setup is underway

Further requirements specifically applying to vehicles that have been to Poland, Czech Republic or Slovakia within 7 days and wishes to have a black certificate changed to a red:

- A map of the positions of the report
- Postcodes or province names for every position
