

# DANISH INFECTION PROTECTION RULES

Safeguarding the introduction of serious infectious diseases such as swine fever and foot-and-mouth disease is essential to prevent outbreaks of diseases with serious economic consequences for Danish agriculture.



**THE FOLLOWING 3 MAIN RULES ARE APPLICABLE**  
prior to entering the herd upon arrival from abroad:

**1.**

**48\* hour quarantine beginning upon crossing the Danish border until the herd area may be entered.**

\* The change in the quarantine duration is temporary and is due to the outbreak of foot-and-mouth disease in Germany.

**2.**

**Prior to accessing the herd area, clothing and shoes must be changed, and a shower must be taken**

**3.**

**Food, hunting trophies and live animals carried along from abroad must NOT enter the herd area**



#### **HAVE YOU BEEN ABROAD?**

Remember to quarantine before you enter the stables!

#### **Desinfection of tools**

All tools must be cleaned and disinfected before entering the stable. Tools follow the same quarantine rules as people.

#### **Visitor log**

Anyone coming from abroad and entering the stable must be registered and confirm compliance of the rules by signature.
